The program is designed to fulfill workforce development needs identified by the NOAA National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) and since 1999, has provided opportunities for 151 Ph.D. students.

The opportunity to apply for 2022 fellowships is now open. Applications are due to Sea Grant programs on January 27, 2022.
