

Preliminary proposal to encode Vatteluttu in Unicode

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1 Introduction

This is a preliminary proposal to encode the Vatteluttu script in Unicode. Its purpose is to present a tentative encoding model for the script. Research is ongoing and a formal proposal is forthcoming, which will contain background information and additional details on the script. Feedback is sought from experts. The code points used here are arbitrary and will likely change once the script is allocated to the Unicode Roadmap.

2 Script Details

2.1 Structure

The general structure of Vatteluttu is similar to that of Tamil. Each consonant letter possesses an inherent vowel. Independent vowels are written using letters. Non-initial forms of vowels are expressed using combining signs. Vowel signs attach to the left, right, or below the base. Some signs consist of two parts, which are written to the left and right of the base. Historically, the script did not possess a *virāma* or *pulli* for silencing the inherent vowel, but such a sign was introduced at a later time. Consonant clusters are represented linearly. In later sources, each bare consonant in a cluster is marked by placing the *virāma* above the letter.

2.2 Character repertoire and representative glyphs

The proposed repertoire is based upon characters that occur in inscriptions and character inventories published in secondary sources. The representative glyphs are normalizations of forms given in these sources and have been designed by the proposal author. The glyphs are intended to be illustrative, not typographically aesthetic. Glyphs may change based upon feedback from the user community.

2.3 Vowels

There are 11 vowel letters:

The ၄၂ VOWEL LETTER E and ၉၂ VOWEL LETTER O are not attested in early sources. They occur in a later source and are produced by adding the sign ၏ VIRAMA to ၆၂ VOWEL LETTER EE and ၁၂ VOWEL LETTER OO, respectively (see figure 20). The vowel letter *AU is not attested in the sources examined thus far.

2.4 Vowel Signs

There are 10 dependent vowel signs:

There is no dependent form for ၂၂ VOWEL LETTER A. The vowel represented by this letter is inherent in each consonant. The dependent forms ၁၂'' VOWEL SIGN E and ၁၂'' VOWEL SIGN O are later additions, as are the corresponding independent letters, and are produced by placing the sign ၏ VIRAMA above the base along with ၁၂' VOWEL SIGN EE and ၁၂'' VOWEL SIGN OO, respectively (see figure 20). A vowel sign for *AU is not attested. Several combinations of a base letter and a vowel sign are rendered as ligatures.

2.5 Consonants

There are 18 consonant letters:

Each consonant letter bears the inherent vowel /a/. In several sources the left terminals of ቗ TA, ቛ RRA, and ቚ NNNA are connected, such that the letters are rendered in as a closed loop. This is a stylistic matter and can be viewed as glyptic variation.

2.6 Aytam

The ፩ VATTELUTTU SIGN AYTAM is used for indicating aspiration (see figure 16). It corresponds to ☂ U+0B83 TAMIL SIGN VISARGA.

2.7 Virama

The ጀ VATTELUTTU SIGN VIRAMA is used for silencing the inherent vowel of a consonant letter. It has no control function and has the same behavior as ወ U+0BCD TAMIL SIGN VIRAMA.

2.8 Punctuation

Script-specific punctuation marks do not occur in the sources examined thus far. Some manuscripts show usage of dashes for separating sections of text. Word boundaries are not distinguished using spaces.

2.9 Collation

The sort order for Vatteluttu is as follows:




Figure 1: Vatteluttu inscription on a copper plate issued by the Chera king Rajashekhar Varman (r. 820–844). The opening text is inscribed in Grantha. These are known as the Vazhapalli plates. An inventory of letterforms occurring in the plates is given in figure 2 below.

It records the grant of land for a church near Kollam and several rights. Shown here are the verso and recto of the first of five plates. The other plates contain inscriptions in Arabic, Hebrew, and Pahlavi. The set is known as the Tharisapalli or Kollam plates.




Figure 4: Reproduction of the Vatteluttu inscription on the copper plates issued by the Chera ruler Bhaskara Ravi Varma (11th c. CE) to the Jewish merchant Issuppu Irappan (= Joseph Rabban) of Cochin, granting land and proprietary rights (from Anquetil-Duperron 1781: plates 1, 2). The verso and recto of the first plate is shown here. The second plate is shown in figure 5.




Figure 5: The verso of the second plate of the grant to Issuppu Irappan (from Anquetil-Duperron 1781: plate 3). The recto of the plate is blank.




Figure 6: A mechanical reproduction of the copper plate shown in 5 above (from Burnell 1874: plate after p. 334). The image has been stitched. The color variation is present in the source from which the image has been extracted.






Figure 9: Vattelutti inscription in the Tirunelli copper plate grant of Bhaskara Ravi Varman, plate 2, verso and recto (from Hultzsch 1891: plate 2, p. 290, 291). Plate 1 is given in figure 8.









Figure 15: Latin translation of the Malayalam text in Vatteluttu in the *Hortus Indicus Malabaricus* (from van Reede tot Drakestein 1678). Continued from figure 14.
