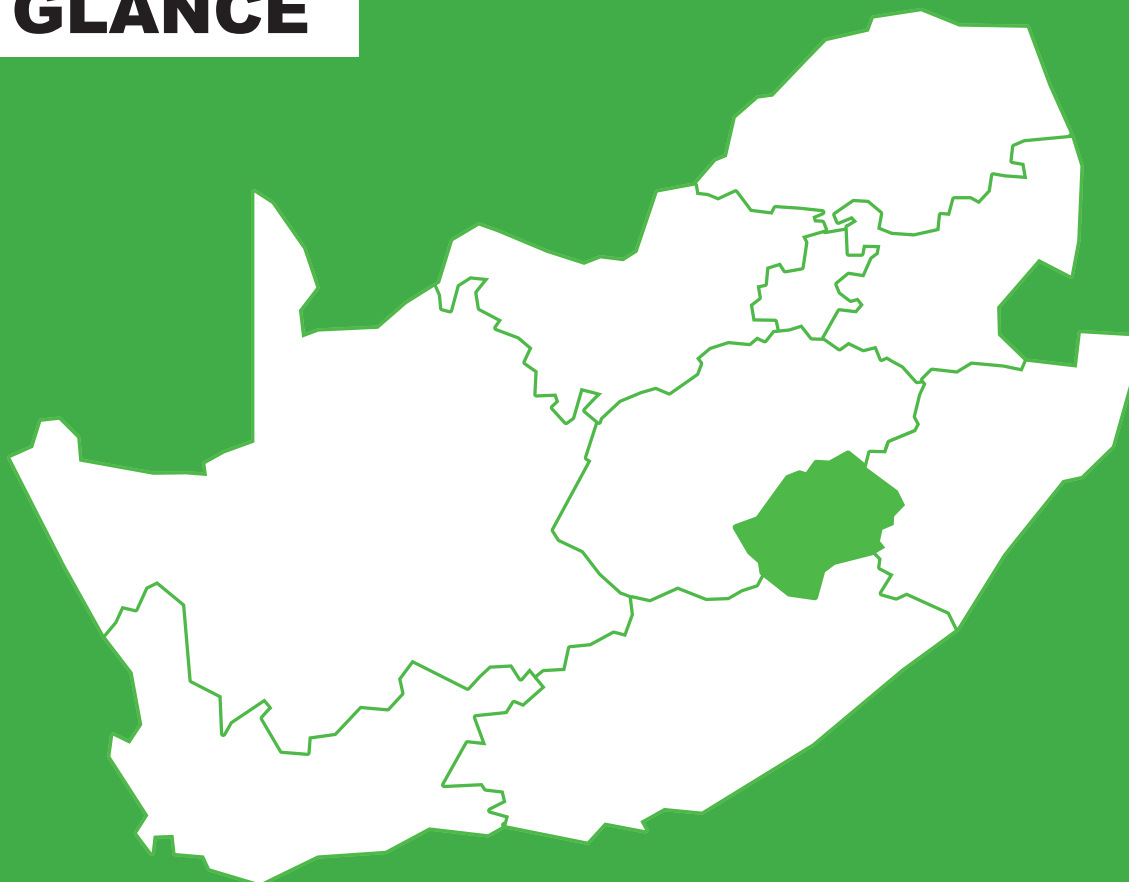

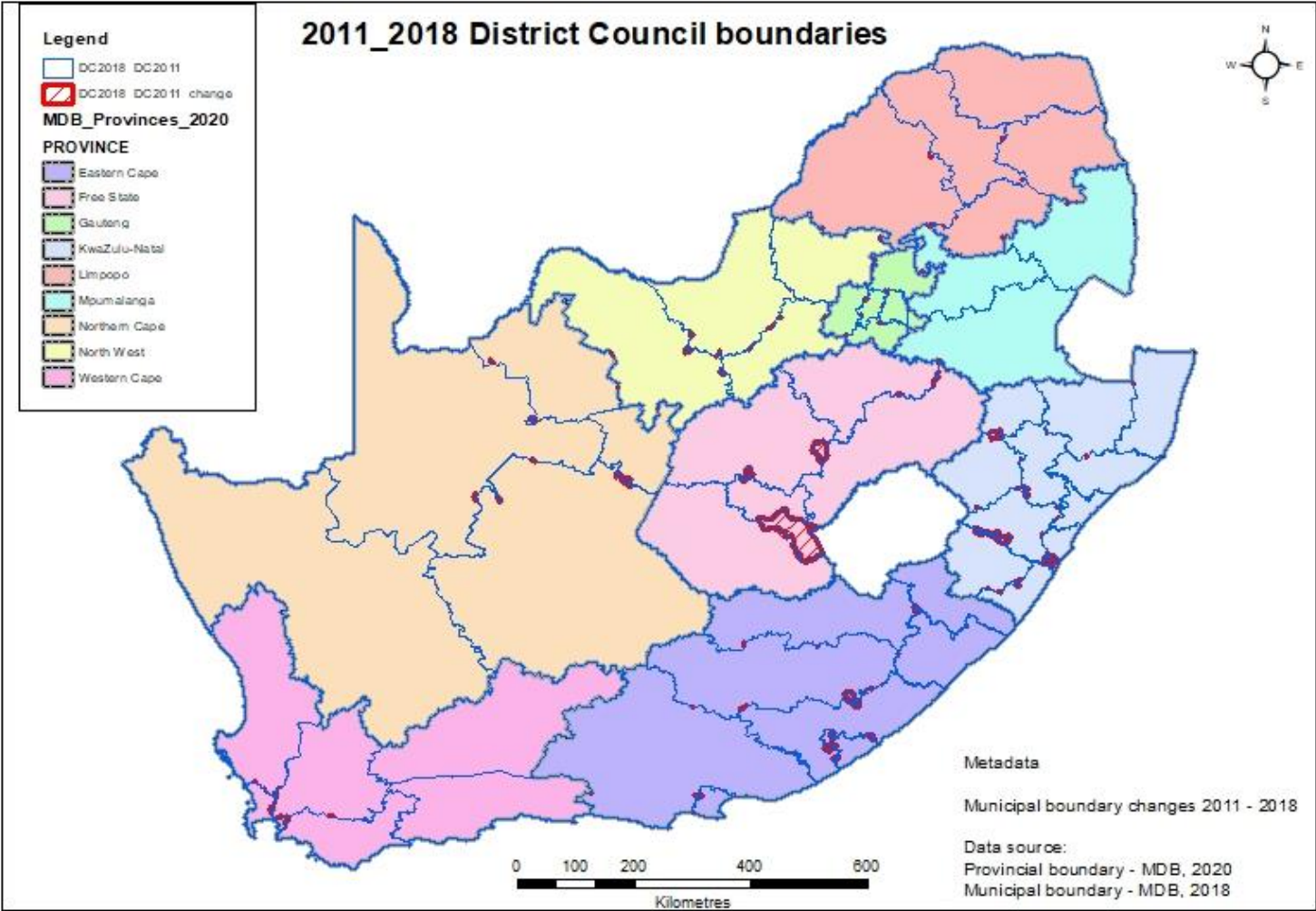

3. Local municipal boundary changes (2011–2018)

In 2011, there were 234 local municipalities. In 2018, the number of local municipalities reduced to 213. The 2018 re-determination of boundaries resulted in three types of boundary changes, which can be categorised as follows:

- **Class 1 – Technical and minor boundary re-determinations**

This re-determination entailed a small-scale boundary adjustment and alignment with a minor impact on the geographic area with no impact on the capacity of the affected municipalities.

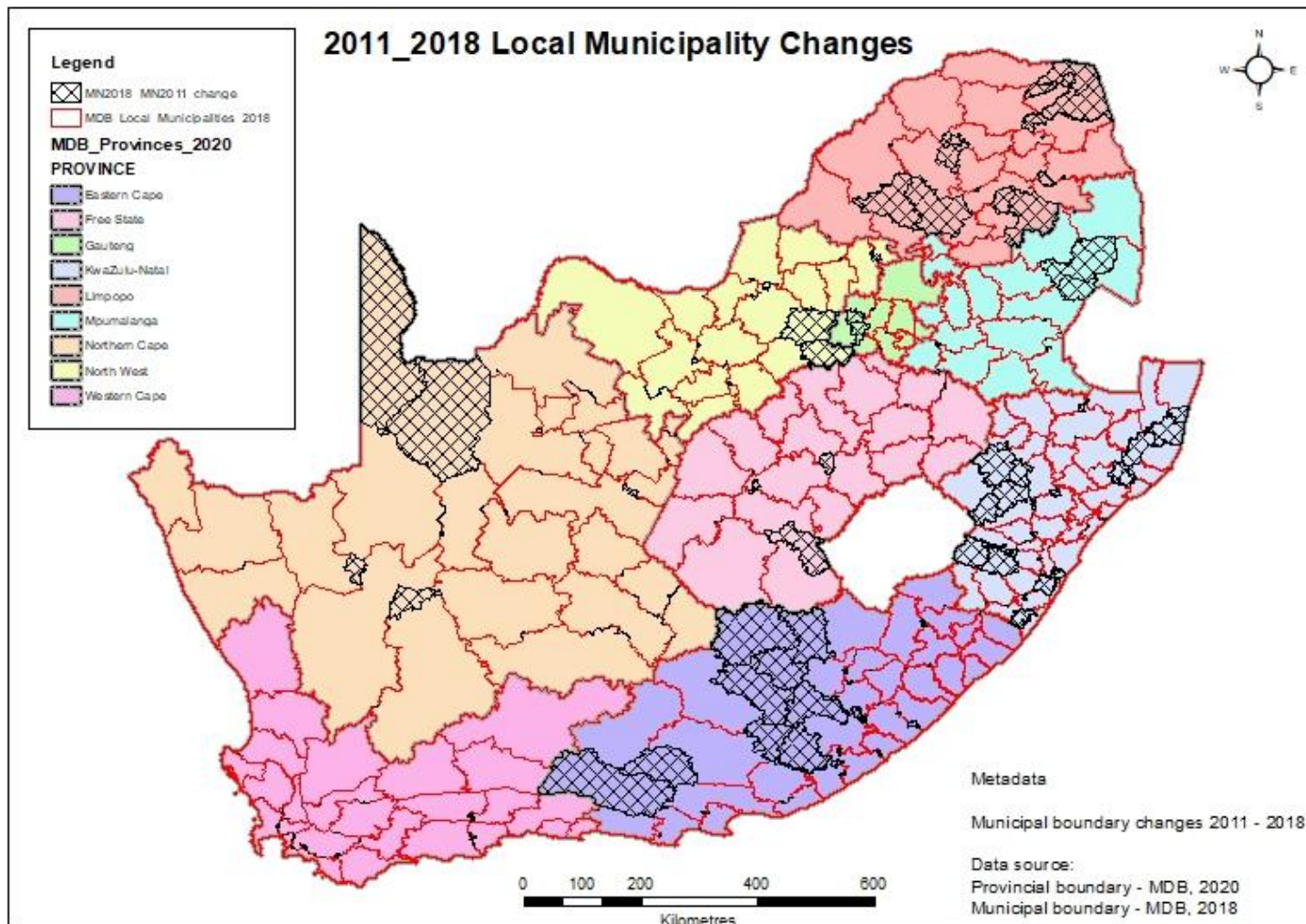
- **Class 2 – Consolidation and annexations**

This was a medium-scale boundary re-determination that may have an impact on a sizable geographic area. This type of determination may impact on ward arrangements but will not materially impact on the capacities of the affected municipalities to deliver services.

- **Class 3 – Amalgamations**

This type of re-determination entailed a major and large-scale municipal boundary re-determination, which will have a significant impact on the geographic areas and the capacities of the affected municipalities. The re-determination includes the merging of adjacent municipalities or the splitting of municipal areas to create other municipal areas.

Map 3: Municipal boundary changes between 2011 and 2018



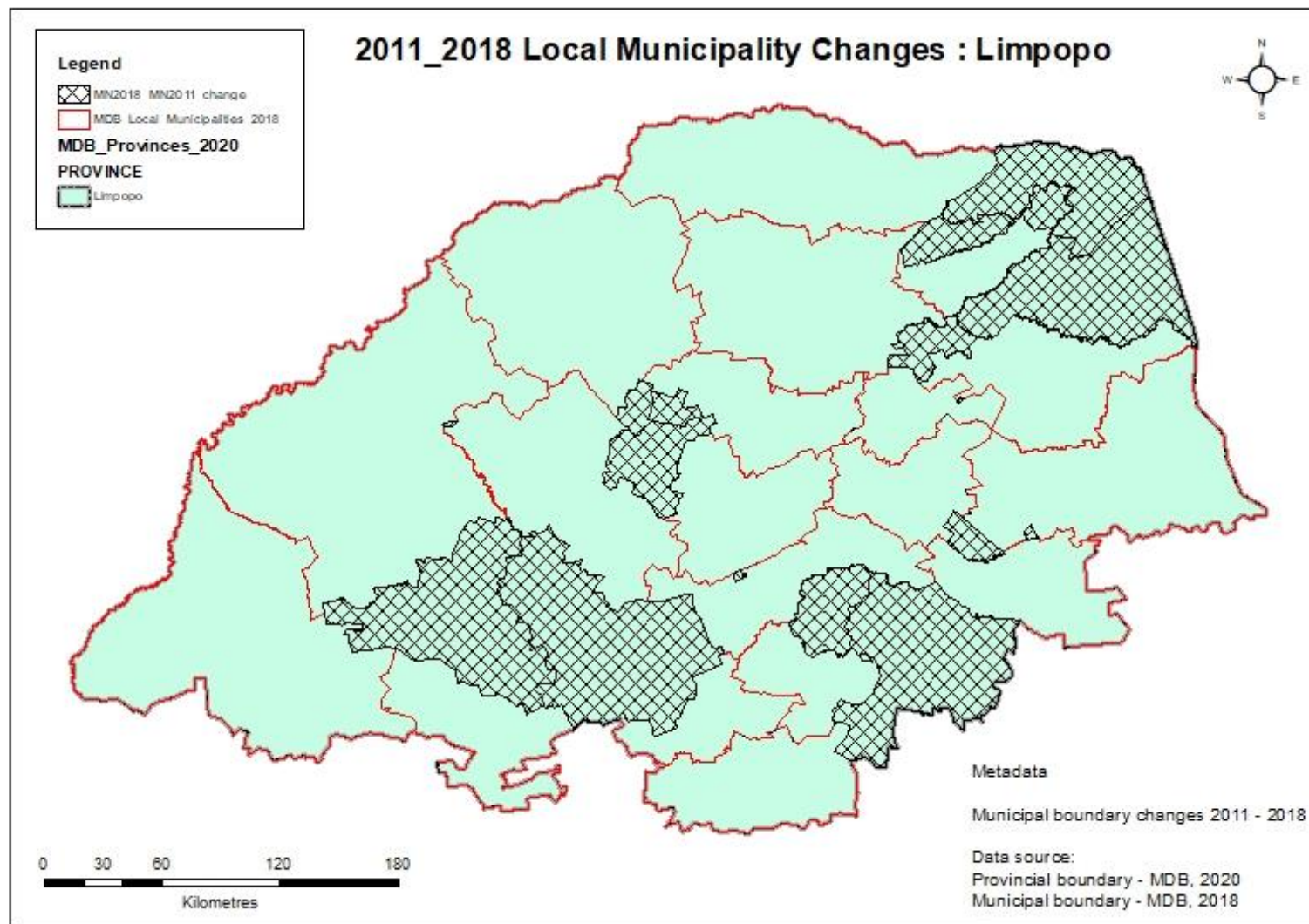
3.1 Local municipal boundary and name changes per province

3.1.1 Limpopo

In 2011, Limpopo had 25 local municipalities which reduced to 22 local municipalities in 2018. Changes to the municipalities in 2018 were as follows:

- The municipality of Aganang was completely dissolved and assigned to three municipalities, namely: Blouberg, Molemole and Polokwane. The area of these three municipalities increased as a result of the inclusion of parts of the dissolved Aganang municipality.
- A new local municipality, Collins Chabane, was created through the combination of part of the Thulamela Municipality with a part of Makhado.
- In Makhado Municipality, an area in the south was allocated to the new Collins Chabane Municipality which resulted in an area reduction from 8 300 km² to 7 605 km².
- Part of Thulamela Municipality was assigned to Collins Chabane Municipality and part of Mutale Municipality was included in its jurisdiction. Its 2018 area reads 2 642 km² which is a reduction from its 2011 area of 5 834 km².
- Mutale Municipality was dissolved and is now included in Thulamela and Musina Local Municipalities.
- Musina gained a part of the dissolved Mutale municipality and its area increased from 7 577 km² to 10 347 km².
- Parts of the Greater Tzaneen Municipality were allocated to Maruleng Local Municipality which resulted in an area reduction of 3 243 km² to 2 896 km².
- Maruleng Local Municipality increased in area from 3 244 km² to 3 563 km² as a result of the allocation of parts of Greater Tzaneen Local Municipality into its jurisdiction.
- Fetakgomo and Greater Tubatse municipalities were merged into one local municipality namely Fetakgomo Tubatse.
- Modimolle and Mookgopong municipalities were merged into one local municipality namely Modimolle-Mookgophong.

Map 3.1.1: Municipality boundary changes in Limpopo

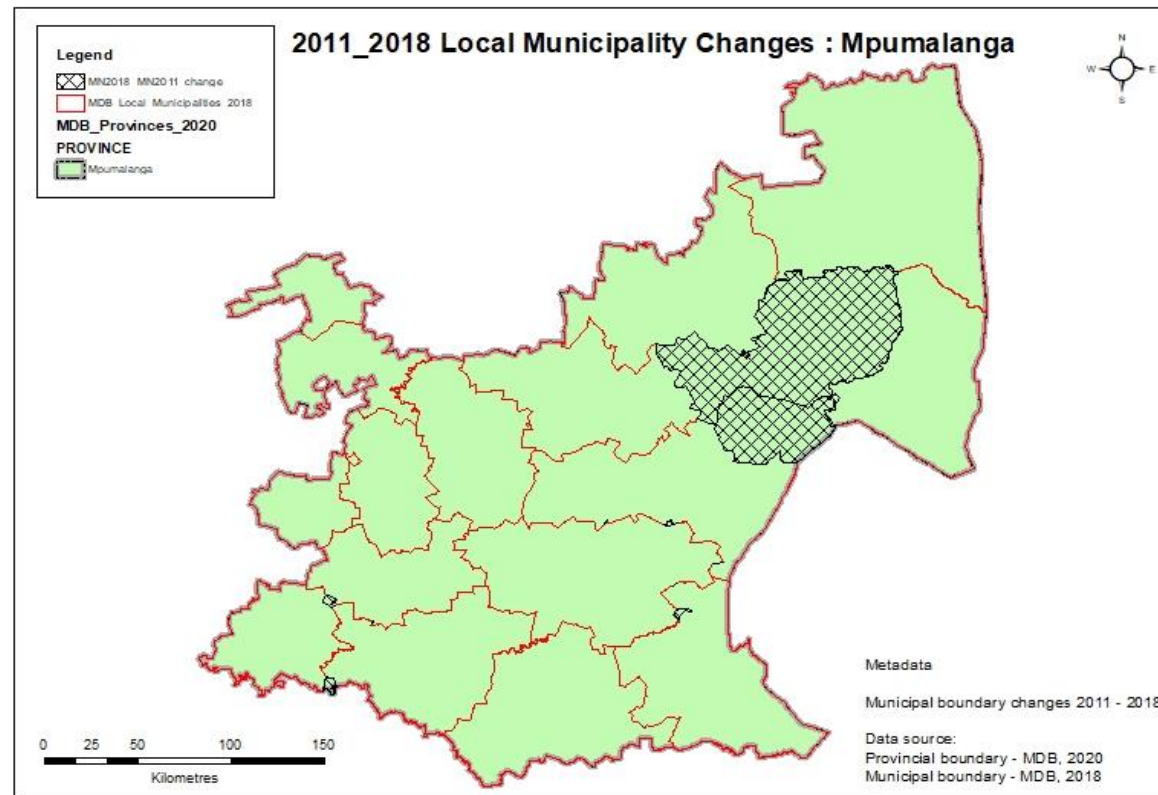


3.1.2 Mpumalanga

In 2011, Mpumalanga had 18 local municipalities which in 2018 reduced to 17 municipalities. Changes to the municipalities in 2018 were as follows:

- Umjindi and Mbombela municipalities merged into one local municipality namely City of Mbombela.
- There were two corrections of municipality names, namely Pixley Ka Seme, was changed to Dr Pixley Ka Isaka Seme and Albert Luthuli was corrected to Chief Albert Luthuli.

Map 3.1.2: Municipality boundary changes in Mpumalanga

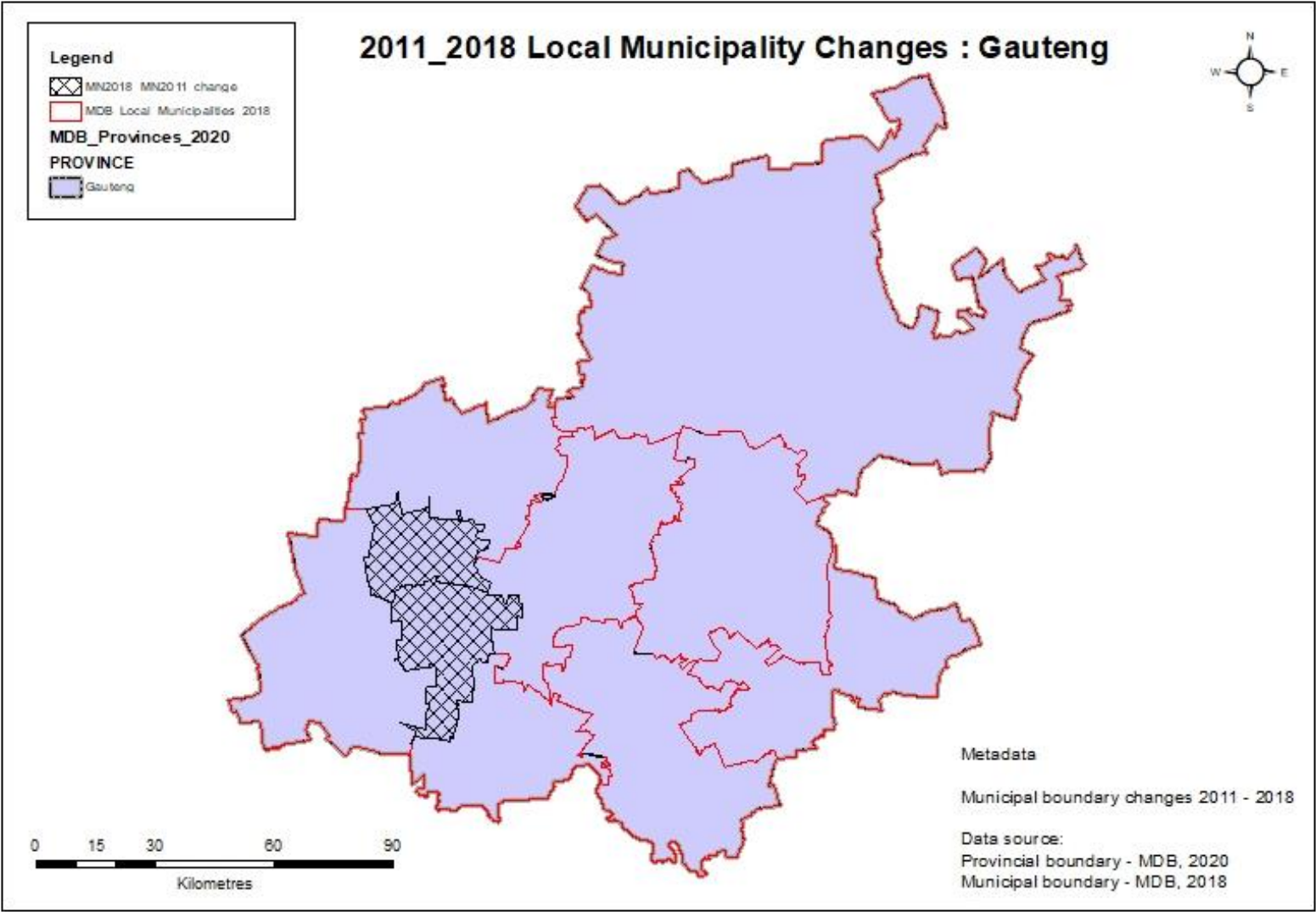


3.1.3 Gauteng

In 2011, Gauteng had three Metropolitan areas and seven local municipalities. In 2018 the metropolitan areas remained unchanged with local municipalities reducing to six. In 2018 the following changes occurred:

- Randfontein and Westonaria municipalities were merged into one local municipality called Rand West City.

Map 3.1.3: Municipality boundary changes in Gauteng

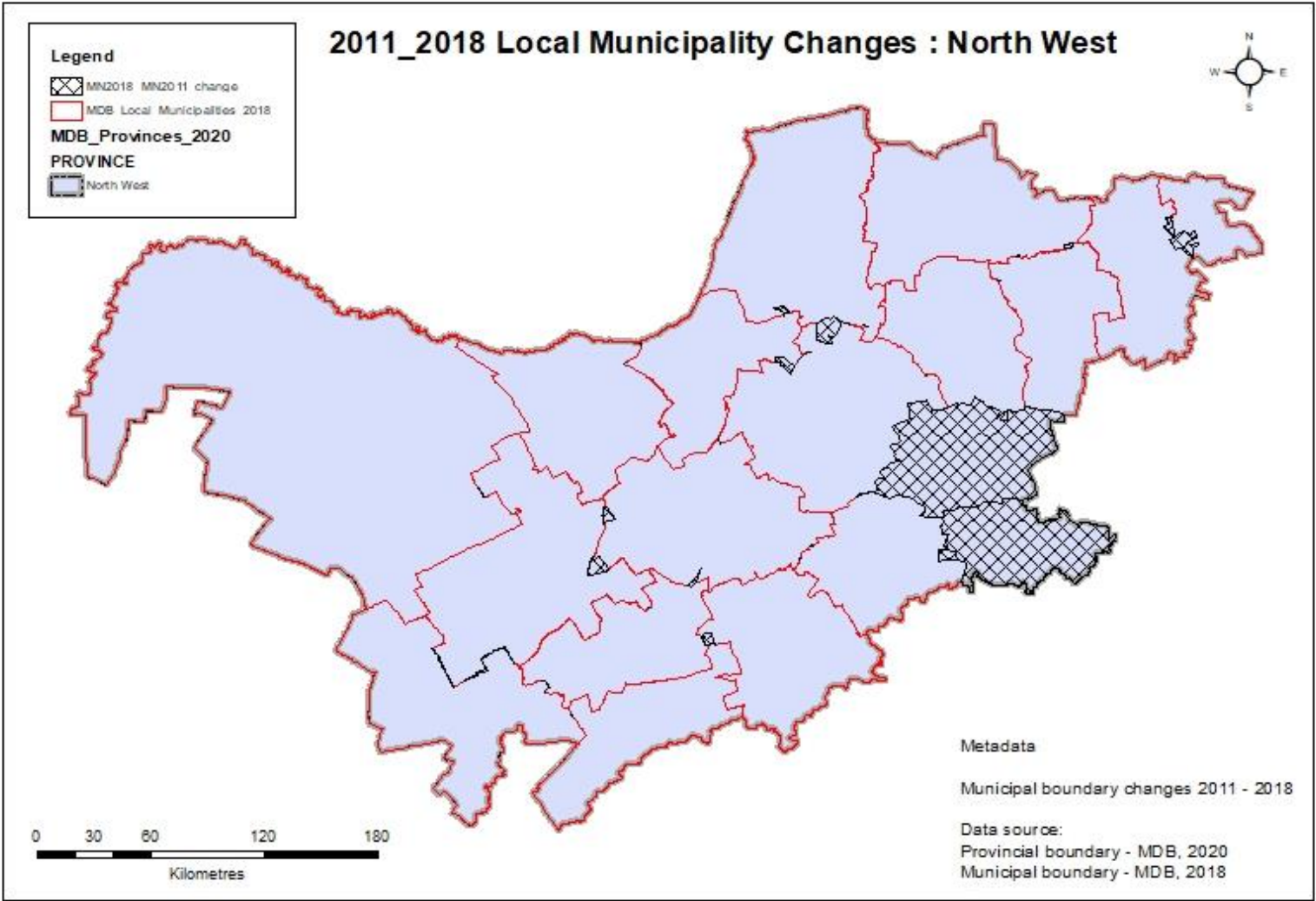


3.1.4 North West

In 2011, North West had 19 local municipalities that reduced to 18 local municipalities in 2018. Changes to the municipalities in 2018 were as follows:

- Ventersdorp and Tlokwe City Council were merged into one local municipality, namely JB Marks.
- There was a minor adjustment on the boundary between Moretele and Madibeng. The municipality of Moretele increased in area from 1 379 km² to 1 498 km². Madibeng local municipality reduced from 3 839 km² to 3 720 km². There was also a name correction of Madibeng to Local Municipality of Madibeng in 2018.
- There were small-scale boundary adjustments in Ramotshere Moiloa, Mahikeng, Ditsobotla, Naledi, Greater Taung, Mamusa, Twaing and City of Motlosana that had no significant impact on the local municipalities.

Map 3.1.4: Municipality boundary changes in North West

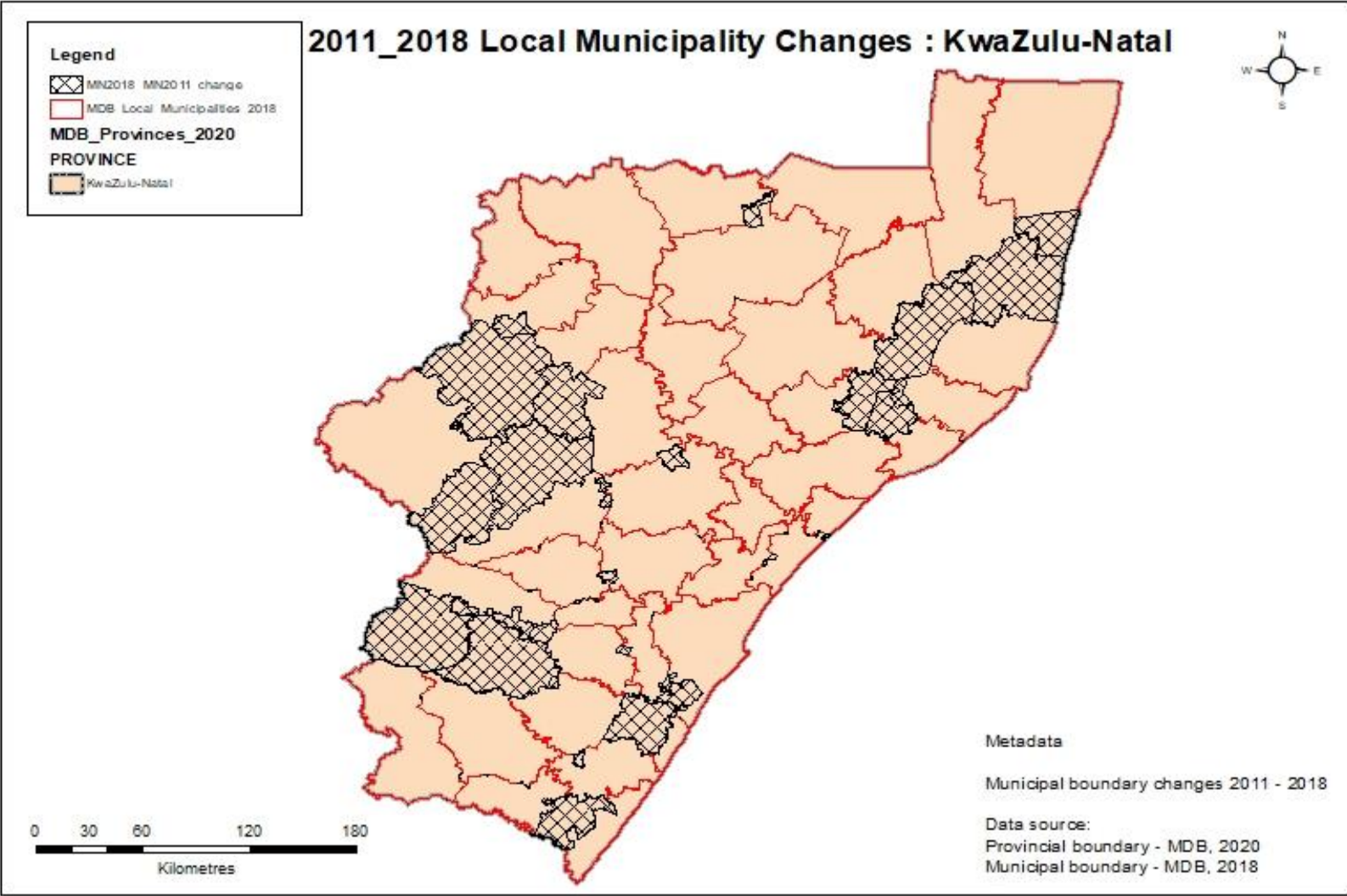


3.1.5 KwaZulu-Natal

In 2011, KwaZulu-Natal had 1 Metropolitan area and 50 local municipalities. In 2018, the province had 1 Metropolitan area and 43 local municipalities. Changes to the municipalities in 2018 were as follows:

- Ntambanana Local Municipality was dissolved, and the area was split between Mthonjaneni and uMhlathuze local municipalities. Mthonjaneni area size increased from 1 086 km² to 1 639 km². uMhlathuze area increased from 793 km² to 1 233 km².
- Emnambithi/Ladysmith and Indaka Local Municipalities were merged into one local municipality, namely Alfred Duma.
- Parts of Emnambithi/Ladysmith Local Municipality were allocated to Dannhauser Municipality. Dannhauser's area slightly increased to 1 707 km² from 1 516 km².
- Ingwe and Kwa Sani municipalities were merged into one local municipality, namely Dr Nkosazana Dlamini Zuma.
- The Big 5 False Bay and Hlabisa municipalities were merged into one local municipality, namely Big Five Hlabisa.
- Vulamehlo and Umdoni municipalities were merged into one local municipality, namely Umdoni.
- eThekweni Metropolitan area increased from 2 291 km² to 2 556 km² through the inclusion of parts of Vulamehlo Municipality and Mkhambathini Municipality into its jurisdiction.
- Ezingoleni and Hibiscus Coast municipalities were merged into one local municipality called Ray Nkonyeni.
- Umtshezi and Imbabazane municipalities were merged into one local municipality, namely Inkosi Langalibalele.
- There were minor adjustments in the boundaries of the following municipalities, namely: Impendle, The uMsunduzi, Ubuhlebezwe, KwaDukuza, Mandeni, Umvoti and Abaqulusi that resulted in a slight increase in their area.
- There were minor adjustments to the boundaries of the following municipalities, namely: Umhlabuyalingana, uPhongolo, uMngeni, Richmond and Umzumbe that resulted in a slight decrease in their area.

Map 3.1.5: Municipality boundary changes in KwaZulu-Natal

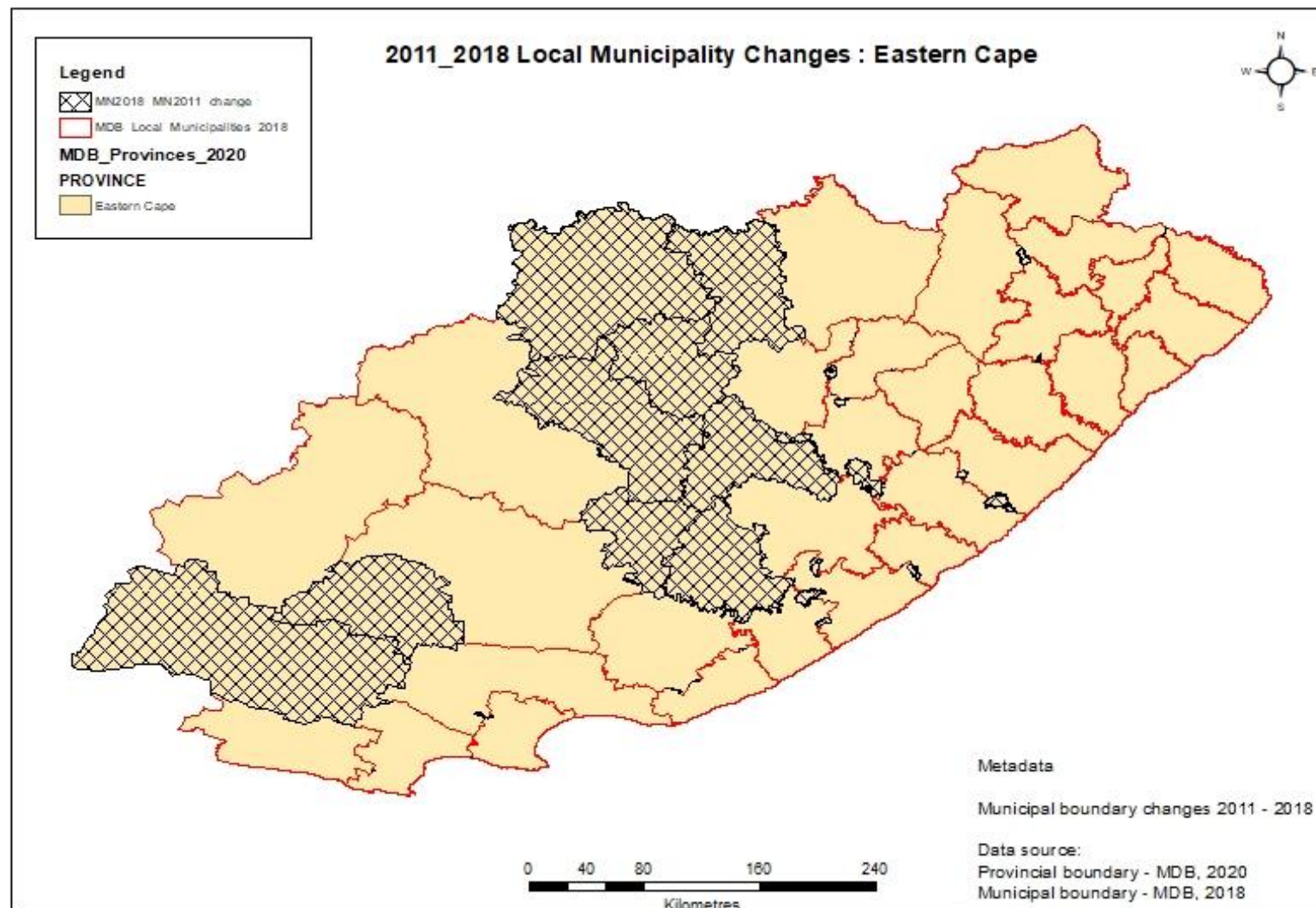


3.1.6 Eastern Cape

In 2011, Eastern Cape had two Metropolitan areas and 37 local municipalities. In 2018, the province still maintained two Metropolitan areas and the local municipalities were reduced to 31. Changes to the municipalities in 2018 were as follows:

- Nkonkobe and Nxuba municipalities were merged into one local municipality, namely Raymond Mhlaba.
- Tsolwana, Inkwanca and Lukanji municipalities were merged into one local municipality, namely Enoch Mgijima.
- Maletswai and Gariep municipalities were merged into one local municipality, namely Walter Sisulu.
- Camdeboo, Ikwezi and Baviaans municipalities were merged into one local municipality, namely Dr Beyers Naudé.
- Buffalo City Metropolitan increased from 2 536 km² to 2 753 km², through the reduction of two adjacent municipalities, namely, Great Kei and Ngqushwa.
- There was a slight change in the boundaries of the following municipalities: Emalahleni, Sakhisizwe, Intsika Yethu, Elundini, Mhlontlo, Amahlathi, Mbhashe and Mquma. These changes did not have a significant geographical impact on these local municipalities.

Map 3.1.6: Municipality boundary changes in Eastern Cape

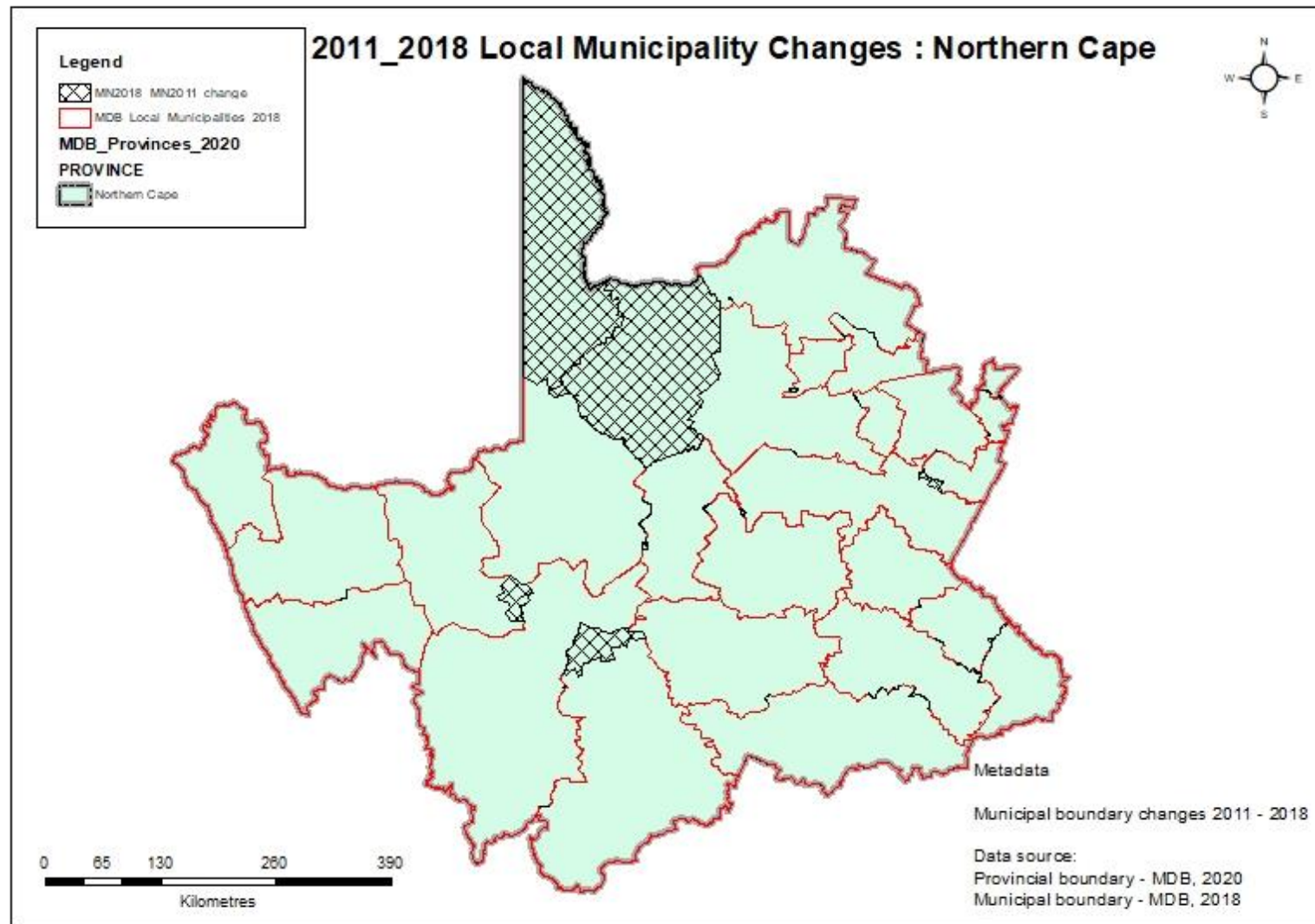


3.1.7 Northern Cape

In 2011, Northern Cape had 27 local municipalities and in 2018 they decreased to 26 local municipalities. Changes to the municipalities in 2018 were as follows:

- Mier and //Khara Hais municipalities merged into one local municipality namely Dawid Kruiper.

Map 3.1.7: Municipality boundary changes in Northern Cape

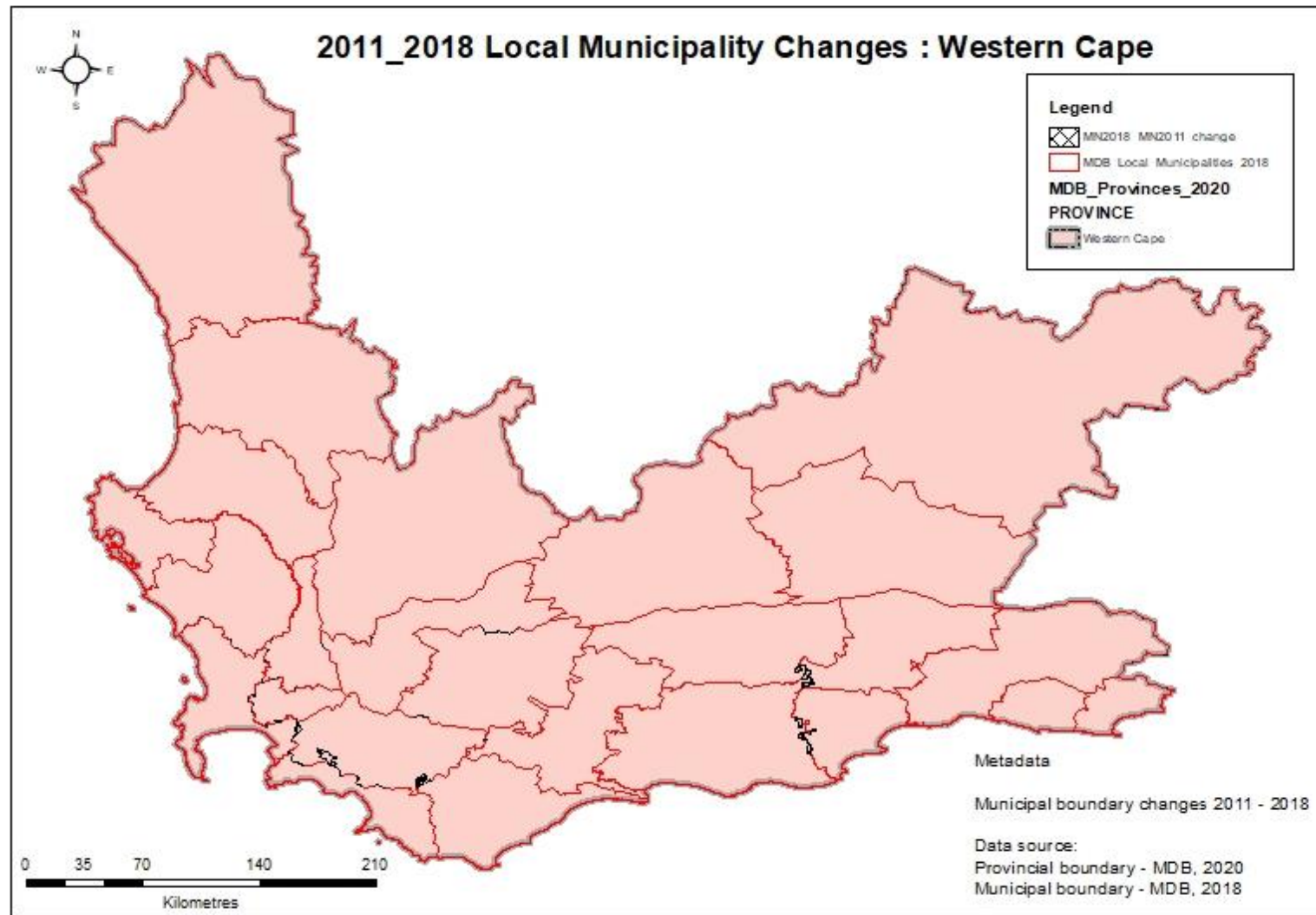


3.1.8 Western Cape

Between the 2011 and 2018 boundary re-determination, there was no change in the number of Metropolitan and local municipality in Western Cape Province. Changes to the municipalities in 2018 were as follows:

- There was stability in boundary and name changes.
- There were few minor technical changes in some boundaries in the following municipalities: Overstrand, Theewaterskloof, Stellenbosch and City of Cape Town.

Map 3.1.8: Municipality boundary changes in Western Cape

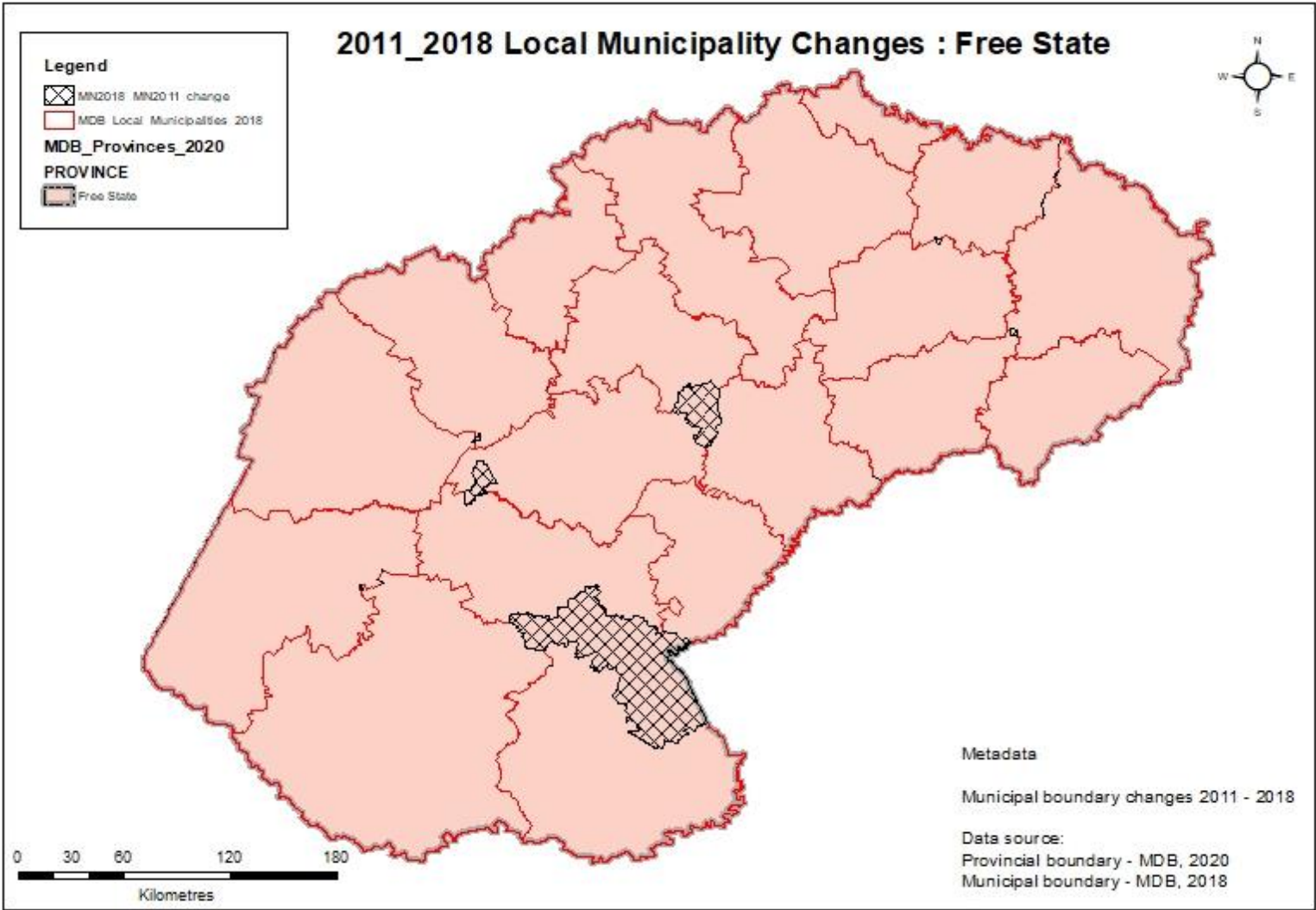


3.1.9 Free State

Between the 2011 and 2018 boundary re-determination, the following changes occurred to the 2011 municipalities:

- Mangaung Metropolitan Municipality received Naledi Local Municipality and part of Masilonyana Local Municipality to increase in area from 6 284 km² to 9 886 km².
- Naledi Local Municipality was incorporated into Mangaung Metropolitan Municipality.
- Masilonyana Local Municipality reduced in area from 6 796 km² to 6 618 km² when part of Masilonyana was included in Mangaung.
- Matjhabeng Local Municipality increased in size from 5 155 km² to 5 690 km² with the inclusion of part of Setsoto Local Municipality.
- Setsoto Local Municipality reduced in area from 5 966 km² to 5 431 km².
