These storms became organized and served as a trigger for other convective development. In addition, thunderstorms developed along a differential heating boundary stretching north to south across the area. These storms pushed across east Central Alabama, triggering additional development.</p>

During the afternoon of June 7th, an isolated severe storm developed in eastern Geneva county and moved into Houston county. This storm produced numerous instances of wind damage, some significant, as it moved across western and central Houston county. By the time it moved into eastern Houston county, the storm weakened to below severe limits as evidenced by the lack of damage reports from the eastern part of the county. However, an unsecured inflatable castle broke loose at the Farley Nuclear Plant during the storm, and one man was killed when a metal pipe from the structure hit him on the head.
