A MCS moving eastward across north Alabama produced an outflow boundary that pushed to the I-20 corridor. The boundary encountered a very unstable air mass with surface based CAPE values near 4000 J/kg in the afternoon. Several clusters of severe thunderstorms developed along the I-20 corridor east of I-65.

Heavy rain caused a water rescue on Mt. Calvary Avenue between Taylor Street and Saxon Street due to the vehicle being trapped in flood waters.

Tropical Storm Cristobal moved west of the Alabama coastal waters on the afternoon of June 7th, 2020. Cristobal made landfall in southeast Louisiana at 5 pm CDT on June 7th with estimated maximum sustained winds of 50 mph. Cristobal then tracked northwest into inland Louisiana late on the night of June 7th into the morning of June 8th.

Cristobal did not produce sustained tropical storm winds across inland areas, sustained tropical storm force winds were limited to immediate coastal locations in southern Mobile and Baldwin counties. Inland of the immediate coast, some areas saw tropical storm force gusts. Damage was limited to very sporadic tree damage.

Storm Surge inundation peaked between 2 to 3.8 feet MHHW across coastal Alabama and Escambia County, FL. Moderate coastal flooding occurred across many coastal locations, particularly in and around the Mobile Bay region. Some roads were closed, including the west end of Dauphin Island, Highway 90 Causeway across Mobile Bay, Shell Belt/Coden Road, the foot of the Dog River Bridge and part of the Cochrane Causeway. More minor coastal flooding was observed further east across the western Florida panhandle.

Rainfall totals of 3 to 10 inches were recorded across southeast Mississippi, southwest Alabama and northwest Florida with the highest totals recorded in Mobile County and George County. The highest total was 10.33 inches in West Mobile.

The tornado first touched down southwest of Kelly Trail and moved northeast across the road. In this area, significant damage was noted to both softwood and hardwood trees with the trunks of many trees snapped. A couple of homes suffered significant damage due to the fallen trees. Another home on the western edge of the tornado path had roof damage to the north side of the structure. The tornado continued northeast and crossed Celeste Road, weakened and lifted just east of John Kelly Road. The tree damage was much more sporadic and not as significant in the Celeste Road area as it was further to the southwest.

A Mesoscale Convective Vortex moved across the area during the morning and early afternoon. Enhanced vertical wind shear with this system combined with a moist and unstable atmosphere led to the development of thunderstorms with embedded mesocyclones, some of which produced tornadoes.
