Deep moisture resided over Alabama on May 22-23 with PWAT values 1.5 to 1.8 inches. Afternoon surface based CAPE values reached 3000-4000 J/kg both days, but steeper mid level lapse rates on May 22 resulted in a majority of the storms producing large hail.

<p>A long-lived complex of thunderstorms which originated over Kansas during the early morning hours, moved through southern Missouri, northern Arkansas and eventually into Tennessee and far north Alabama during the late afternoon and early evening hours. The thunderstorms produced a gust front that pushed south and southeast away from the rain area into far north Alabama.
