National Weather Service meteorologists surveyed damage in Elmore County and determined that it was consistent with an EF 0 tornado, with maximum winds near 70 mph. An isolated, low-topped supercell produced a weak, brief tornado along Pleasant Hill Road about 8.9 miles northeast of Wetumpka. About a dozen large trees were uprooted sporadically along the path in a convergent pattern near the center of the path, with weaker tree limb damage on the outskirts of the path. A tree fell on a barn. One manufactured home had a roof partially removed with minor damage to a deck and skirting.

A line of thunderstorms ahead of a cold front produced a weak tornado in Elmore County during the afternoon hours.
