




# **FALLS RESERVE Conservation Area**

#### **Severe Storm Emergencies**

If a severe weather warning is issued, bring everyone in your party together and seek shelter in a safe, secure area. Washroom buildings would be considered a safer place to seek shelter. DO NOT seek shelter from a tornado in your tent, mobile trailer or vehicle. If you're not able to get to a washroom building, seek shelter in a low lying area away from hazards such as overhead power lines and trees. After the storm, staff will assess any personal injuries, hazards and damages and take necessary actions. Contact staff or tune into local radio stations for weather forecasts or potential storm threats.

## First Aid and Emergencies

First aid kits for the treatment of minor cuts and scrapes are located at the Gatehouse, the park office and in each park vehicle. Trained staff can provide basic first aid on request. For serious accidents, staff will provide assistance and put you in touch with professional care.
