Profile

The bachelor's programme Business Administration offers a solid subject-specific education combined with a strong practice orientation.

Soft skills, business English, participative and digital exercises and practical projects as well as the option to spend a semester abroad complement the syllabus. Thus, the study programme prepares you for a career entry as junior executive or for studies in a master's programme.

The objective of the programme: You acquire both the subjectrelated expertise as well as personal and social skills to work as a corporate junior executive or specialist. The sound education in business administration is perfectly tailored to both current and future corporate requirements. The basis of the programme includes: network and solution-oriented thinking, solid subject-specific and methodical knowledge, practice-oriented development of alternative courses of action, the training of social skills and the ability to communicate.

The programme's concept is closely aligned to corporate requirements in practice.

The programme is based on the teaching of modern business administration topics, mathematics and statistics, economics, accounting and taxation, current business law and economic informatics.

In specialisation modules, you can focus on subjects such as controlling, corporate tax planning, German employment law, IT applications, financial or marketing management.

In addition, you can choose from a number of important modules, e.g. subject-specific foreign language skills, working methods, negotiation or presentation techniques.

Towards the end of your studies, you apply the acquired subject-related, methodical and social skills to projects and case studies.

The study programme concludes with a bachelor's thesis and a colloquium.

Please note: The language of instruction is mainly German.

Career Options

The bachelor's programme Business Administration qualifies you for demanding tasks with promising promotion prospects towards management positions.

Potential areas of employment are controlling, IT, marketing, human resources management, tax consultancy, corporate consulting and auditing.
